

- encouraging their tutees to involve themselves in a range of co-curricular activities and monitoring the balance between academic and co-curricular commitments;
- building up a trustful, concerned relationship with their tutees;
- generally monitoring all aspects of their tutee's development;
- liaising with the relevant Head of Playroom and Pastoral Head over their tutees' well-being and progress;
