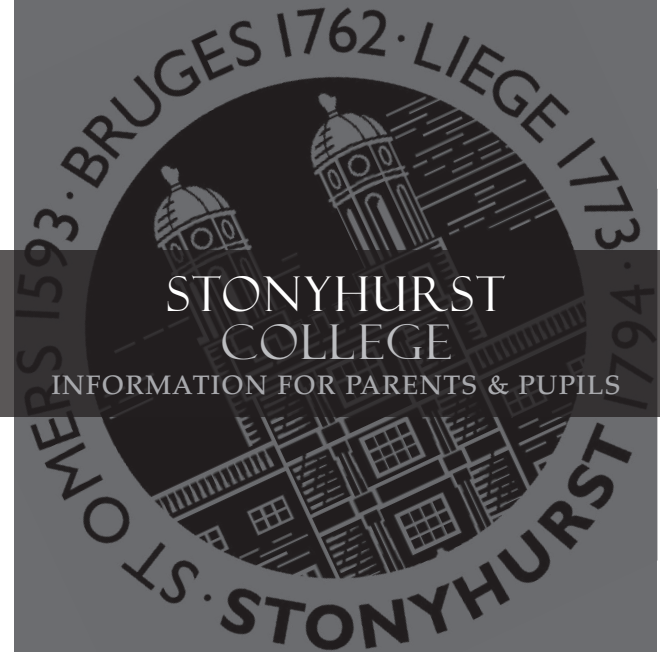

## TUTORIAL SYSTEM

The **Tutorial system** at the College is an integral part of the care and support we provide for our pupils. Tutors meet with their tutees at least once a week. At least once a fortnight, they will have a one-to-one meeting with each tutee. The Tutor's responsibilities involve many aspects including:

- discussion with tutees and challenging them on their academic progress;
- giving tutees careers guidance including advice about subject choices;
- taking an interest in and checking their studies;
- encouraging their tutees to involve themselves in a range of co-curricular activities and monitoring the balance between academic and co-curricular commitments;
- building up a trustful, concerned relationship with their tutees;
- generally monitoring all aspects of their tutee's development;
- liaising with the relevant Pastoral Head over their tutees' well-being and progress;
- liaising with parents and writing reports.

## PUPIL WELFARE

### Worries, Concerns & Complaints

Things do not always go well at school and pupils should feel confident that there is always someone available who can help them overcome whatever difficulties may arise in all areas of school life.

### Pastoral

The Deputy Head (Pastoral) and Deputy Head (Higher Line) (for Poetry and Rhetoric) oversee pastoral matters but day-to-day concerns are the responsibility of the Playroom Masters/Mistresses/Housemistresses and designated staff. Tutors play an important role and are allocated at the beginning of each year. The College Chaplains in the Emmaus Centre have a significant input as well, as does the Health Centre. Problems can appear to be insurmountable but help is there when required. Any member of staff associated with the pupil's Playroom/House is available to assist and the Health Centre staff are always willing to help.

### Academic

The Director of Studies and the Deputy Head (Learning) have overall responsibility for this area but the Deputy Head (Higher Line), Heads of Faculty, Heads of Department and Tutors, liaising with all of the pupil's teachers, endeavour to keep a close check on pupils' progress. It is important that difficulties should first of all be discussed with subject teachers, but if pupils find this difficult, their Tutor will act as an intermediary. The Director of Studies or Deputy Head (Higher Line) in the case of Poetry and Rhetoric will take up persistent difficulties.

### Disciplinary

The Deputy Head (Pastoral) promulgates school disciplinary procedures but classroom discipline is largely the responsibility of individual teachers, while the appropriate Playroom Master/Housemistress usually addresses disciplinary matters outside the classroom. Serious disciplinary matters are dealt with immediately by the Deputy Head (Pastoral) or the Deputy Head (Higher Line) in the case of Poetry and Rhetoric. In disciplinary situations there can be occasions when sanctions are perceived as unfair, and all pupils have a right to express complaints in an appropriate manner. A sensible approach to a person issuing a punishment can usually lead to clarification but, failing this, a pupil's Playroom Master/Housemistress can assist. The Deputy Head (Pastoral) is also available at any time.

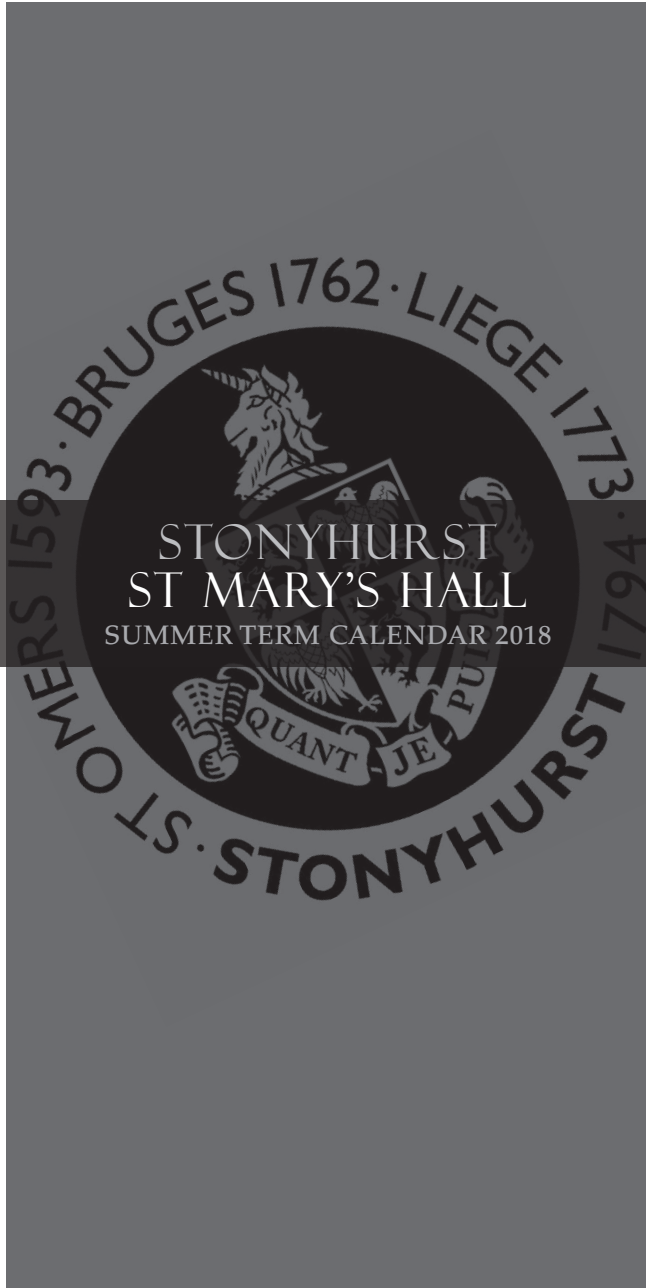
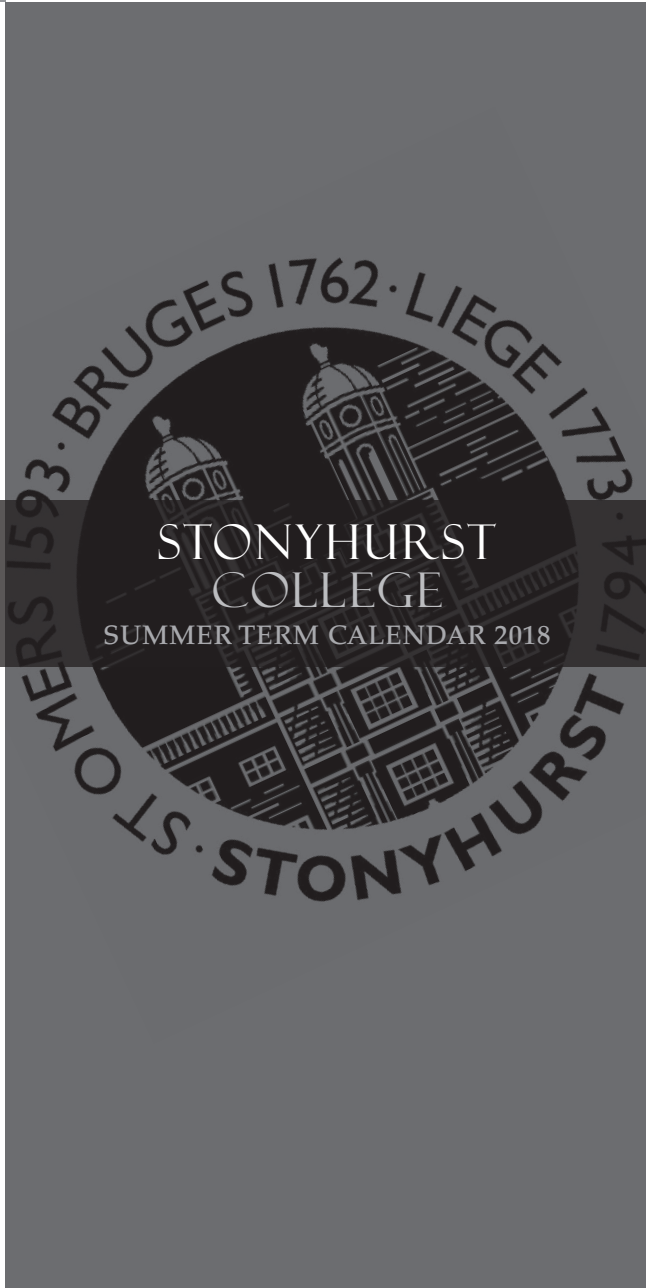

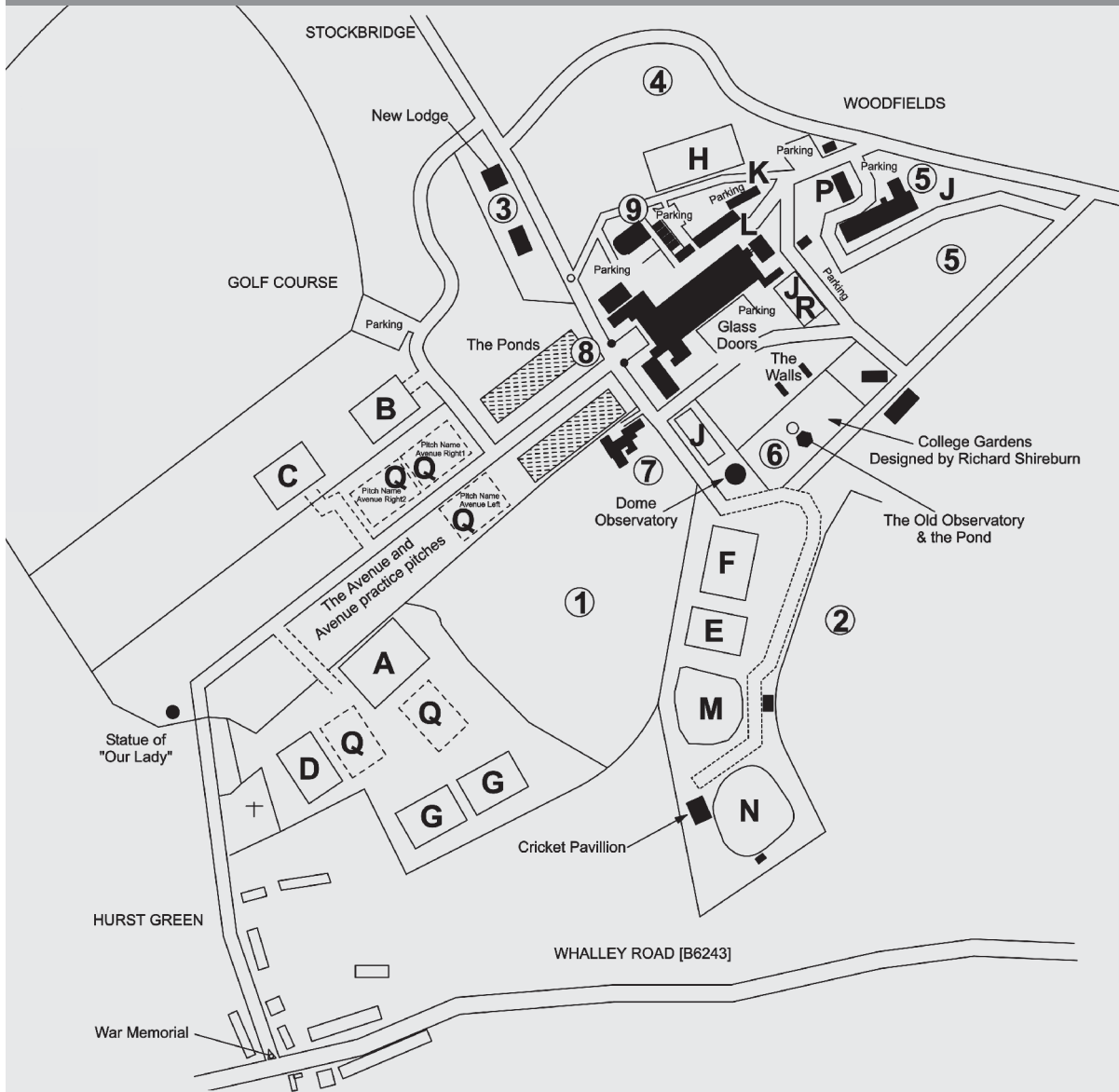
